Level 2 Award and Certificate in Youth Work Practice and/or Level 3 Diploma in Youth Work Practice

Somerset Youth & Community Service and the Regional Youth Work Unit at Learning South West are pleased to offer the new Level 2 and Level 3 qualifications in Youth Work Practice in 2015/16.

The courses will be taught together, in Somerset, starting in early October 2015, and we expect learners will have achieved their qualification by July 2016.

Who should apply?

- The **Level 2 Award** provides an introduction to youth work, and is the starting point for the Level 2 Certificate and Level 3 Diploma.
- The Level 2 Certificate is suitable for those who have recently started youth work, either as a paid worker or a volunteer.
- More experienced youth workers and volunteers, especially those with responsibility for leading youth work sessions will benefit from taking the **Level 3 Diploma**

To achieve the qualifications, you will need to:

- Attend taught sessions and complete a portfolio that shows you understand the principles of youth work and can work with young people successfully
- ➤ Be confident that you have the literacy and numeracy skills needed to undertake a Level 2 or Level 3 qualification though support can be provided for those with special learning needs
- > Be working in a youth work setting on a regular basis, either as a paid worker or a volunteer

You will also need support from your organisation, especially your line manager, who should provide regular supervision, and be able to complete witness statements for your portfolio.

How will it work?

Everybody will do the Level 2 Award at the start of their training, then opt to do either the Level 2 Certificate or Level 3 Diploma, depending on their experience, ability and potential to lead youth work sessions.

Course Content

All courses consist of 'units' covering different aspects of youth work practice. We have selected the following units:

How much will it cost?

Somerset County Council, through its Youth & Community Service is providing a generous subsidy for these courses, for those who do their youth work in Somerset. If you work in Somerset you will only need to pay £25 for the Level 2 Certificate and £50 for the Level 3 Diploma. If you do your youth work outside of Somerset, you will need to pay the full course fees of £780 for the Level 2 Certificate and £1,100 for the Level 3 Diploma.
